



Florida: Hess opens campaign account

Former Circuit Judge **Glenn Hess** opened a campaign account Monday as a candidate for state attorney.

There have been rumors for months that **Hess**, who resigned from his position in January after 13 years on the bench, would challenge incumbent State Attorney Steve Meadows.

According to the Department of State Division of Elections Web site, **Hess** opened his account as a Democrat. Meadows recently changed from Democrat to Republican, meaning their contest will be decided in the general election on Nov. 4 if both win or go uncontested in the primary elections.

Neither candidate has formally announced.
